It has a perfect natural environment as a habitat for migratory birds! It is very stunning to see 20 species of migratory birds flying to the wetlands around November in preparation for the winter.

It's famous for its beautiful scenery along with the cherry blossom road stretching out along the railway. All riders can feast their eyes on the place to take the evocative pictures.

Made with blocks engraved with the names of figures that imagine and desire to see the beauty of Korea, the beautiful road is 155 meters long. 20,000 names are inscribed on the Imagination Road. "Imagination Book" presents the name and nationality of each of 200,000 people named it the book.

Ever since beginning of its usage with MBC's "Kim Su-Ro" (The Iron King), KBS' "The Princess Man", NBS' "The Three Musketeers", and MBC's "Rebel: Thief Who Stole The People" have been film at the site. Iron production site, dock, sailboat, and weaponry of Gaya, as well as living customs and culture of the old times can be experienced first hand.

Jinju

Chokseongnu Pavilion is a tourist attraction that represents the culture and history of Jinju. It is one of the three popular places where Kim Shi-min defeated 20,000 Japanese army with just 3,800 military force in 1592.

This is the first rail-bike place in Gyeongnam region, which stretches along Namsang River, the beautiful view of the island, the oak fishing pier, and the sea with the sunset.

It consists of a forest museum, a tropical botanic garden, a wildlife zoo, a rose-of-sharon museum, a botanical garden, an ecologic glasshouse, a folk botanical garden, a forest park, an arboretum, all those facilities are decorated by theme.

Grafting "Ena," which means "truth" or "real" in Jinju dialect, Ena Road is a trail road of "Three Musketeers" and MBC's "Rebel: Thief Who Stole The People" have been film at the site. Iron production site, dock, sailboat, and weaponry of Gaya, as well as living customs and culture of the old times can be experienced first hand.

Tongyeong

Let's go ride the Tongyeong Cable Car if you want to observe the real scenery of Hallyeo Waterway. The scenery from the top of Mirae Mountains is truly moving. The specialty of Tongyeong is the wheeled sledge, luge! Experience the thrill of racing down the winding track on a slide of harmony with the natural landscape.

The park lies 21.5 km to the south of Tongyeong Port (takes 50 minutes to get from the port). It's a beautiful island belonging to Hallyeosudo with abundant wild flowers and trees including silver magnolia, camellia trees.

Strange rocks and bizarre stones surrounding the island display the compelling scene. Monggol Coast, which connects Somaemuldo Island and Deungdae Island, and the rugged cliff bring the breathtaking view.

It's like walking through the world of fairytales as you follow the meandering alley of colorful murals. Take a photo with the tree as the background, and admire the atmosphere of the harbor at Dongpo.

Sacheon

The 5 bridges connect Sacheon-Si and Namhae-Gun. Won the "Grand Prize" of the Hundred Roads of Beauty in Korea. Connecting island to island, and island to the sea, this gift of nature forms a 3.4 km of harmony with the natural landscape.

It's one of the nine Korean sunsets designated by Korea Tourism Organization in 2000, harmonizing the view of the island, the oak fishing pier, and the sea with the sunset.

The Museum has been attracting many students for their field trips as there are plenty of resources they can learn about the aerospace industry.

The form of Bito Island much resembles a flying rabbit known for the mud flat, the leading site of the Royal Tomb of King Suro, Gyeongju and other main scenes of the city located nearby can all be seen in the coexistence of past and present of the city.

Gimhae

The park is a complex cultural space that is well known as a resting place for people to experience various cultures with their family friends.

King Suro was the founder of the Geumgwan Gaya Kingdom in 44 BC, and was the first father of the 4 million strong Gimhae Kim Clan. The tomb is a round grave mound that is magnificent in its appearance.

Haebancheon with its prosperous overseas trade of glorious Gaya, along with the Royal Tomb of King Suro, Gyeongju and other main scenes of the city located nearby can all be seen in the coexistence of past and present of the city.

Miryang

Visitors would learn about the Korean ancestors' taste for arts and perspectives from the gorgeous scene. It's one of three great pavilions of Korea together with Choksooku Pavilion of Jinju and Bubyeoknu Pavilion of Pyeongsang.

It is known as a historical site where Reverend Samyeong saved the country as a monk during Japanese Invasion of Korea. The temple possesses numerous cultural remains, including national treasures, treasures, important collection of folklore reference.

Located at an outdoor valley 600-750m above sea level. In this abnormal temperature region, the ice freezes from early spring and melts from the end of August. Visitor flows at the site all year round.

Wiyang pond holds all beauties of the nature. With the circumference of 160m, this tiny pond has 4 islands embellished with drooping willow and fringes to perfect its scenery. It's also known as the filming site of SBS' "Moon Lovers: Scarlet Heart Ryeo".

Geoje

It consists of an observatory, a concert garden, resting facilities along with plenty of spectacles including dinosaur rock, dinosaur cave, footprints of dinosaurs, and strange rocks and bizarre stones.

The island was designated as the second scenic spot in 1971 in the recognition of its compelling natural scene. It delivers various scenes being washed by waves and wind for a million million of years.

With its beautiful scenery and crystal clear water, the beach runs for 1.1 km long. It is the perfect beach to enjoy as its sand is soft, water level is gradual, and the water temperature sits just right.

Hold the wind in your arms on the hill of cobalt ocean and giant windmills. The complete view of Gyeongju Village and its spotted islands can be seen in a sight. The view of the Aegan Sea looked out from Sinsaedae Cliff is truly beautiful.

Yongsan

It possesses the Bubo (treasure of Buddha) of the three treasures, which is regarded as the most honorable. It's truly the "jewel temple of Buddha" and "the big temple of the land". This temple holds the relics of Buddha such as his bonneting, robe, a begging bowl that monk Jang brought from China (Tang).

As a largest theme park within Busan, Gyeongnam-do, it is equipped with diverse facilities and lodging, including 30 types of amusement facilities, large pool, natural lake, event square, and large outdoor venue.

It's the best leisure complex in Yeongnam area that runs all the year round, serving as a golf field or a ski slope depending on the season.

The museum exhibits cultural assets excavated in Yongsan to allow the visitors to understand the history and culture of Yongsan. The children can experience diverse activities, such as the rubbing, archery, and costume. The visits and experience programs are free of charge.

Uiryeong

This is a shrine where General Gwak Jae-u and his military force, the first armed forces raising to defeat Japan in 1592, were enshrined.

Those who wish to gain good eye pass Sotbawi Rock and visit the house of Lee Byung-chul, the founder of Samsung.

The entrance sloping towards the blue stream reservoir, its mountains, rocks, and the pavilion are all referred to as Bonghwangdae. Bonghwangdae is considered as the miniature of the grandeur Gungnam unfold, as the scenery presented by strange rocks and bizarre stones are astonishing.

Seolhwanon is based on the theme of the love story between Hamu, Eungchong, and the gobbi. Visitors enjoy taking photographs with the gobbi, and whisper old tales on this street. If we touch the gobbi magnetdoek, will we be rich?

Haman

- 1 Haman Marisan Ancient Tombs

The tombs, regarded as the Kings' of Ara Gaya, consist of 37 grave mounds in a line while delivering the vivid image of Gaya's glorious history.

Ipgok Reservoir flows meanderingly like a snake's moves. Ipgok County Park is formed at the upstream, where all natural ecology is reserved to provide country residents and citizens with a rest area.

A special experience where you can see and ride on a horse! Haman Horse Riding Park provides diverse horse riding courses that foster racethorses. Spend a day on the donkey coach, along with trekking through the forest.

A pavilion at the north cliff of Akyang Village established in 1857 (Joseon Cheongjo 8), Namsang River flows down the cliff, the scenery is exceptional joined by the dike and wide field of Beopju-Myeon. It is where the popular song "Virgin Boatwoman" originates.

Changnyeong

It's the largest wetland in Korea, exhibiting the natural assets. The vast but serene wetland is the home to numerous natural creatures such as irises, reed, prickly waterlily and so on.

78°C sulfur hot spring contains 20 types of minerals. Bugok Hot Spring is famous for respiratory disease, skin disease. The facility includes lodging, golf course, and other convenient facilities.

In every season, the park welcomes a lot of climbers coming to enjoy the fragrance of azalea in spring, silver grass field in summer, the golden silver grass in autumn, and the snowy scene in winter is also one of the enticing parts of the park.

Following the cliffs of Nakdong River, it is in the limelight for an attraction for a walking tour. Forest of bamboo trees bustling against one another in the trees, and the blinding scenery drawn by Nakdong River is a true grandeur.

Goseong

In the park, the natural scene from the bedrock and rugged precipice allows you to experience the prime of beauty along with the dinosaur footprint from the Cretaceous period of the Mesozoic Era.

The tourist site is designed for descendants to admire the admiral Yi Sun-shin who sacrificed himself for the sake of his country to defeat 57 Japanese warships during the period of Japanese invasion of Korea.

The famous dinosaur of Goseong, Iguanodon, is projected at Korea's first Dinosaur Museum. World's highest dinosaur tower, and observatory is available in the square across from the museum.

With the focus on the mask of Joseon, the most popular culture is course 1, Ogwangdae, domestic masks used in mask plays, and foreign seas of diverse nations are exhibited. Mask making session, and children's folklore class are operated.

Namhae

The highlight of Namhae tour is the view of Hallyeodo from Boriam. Boriam holds the story Taepo Lee Seong-Gye, who achieved the dream of Joseon's establishment. Along with Yangyang Naksansa, and Ganghwa Bomnusa, it has been known as one of the three holiest prayer site.

The southernmost, Nam-Myeon seaside village known for its driving course is arranged with terraced paddy of small size to over 300 pyeong against the blue ocean and slopes.

Pointy red roofs against the blue Namhae Ocean is exotic. German mine workers and nurses have settled here after their retirement. The steep alley and refreshing sea set forth is like a painting. Mudflat experience is available, and Beer Festival is held in October.

It's fun to find 10 courses of Namhae Island's Baraegil. The most popular culture is course 1, Ogwangdae, domestic masks used in mask plays, and foreign seas of diverse nations are exhibited. Mask making session, and children's folklore class are operated.

Hadong

When April comes, the cherry blossom rushes spring to come with its petals flying for 100-Li. The blossom road at full bloom is known for 104 cherry blossom. It is also known as "Holly-Gil (wedding road)" because when two young lovers hold their hands while walking this road, they are to grow old together.

Monk Sambeop brought sacred relics of Haeinsa, the 8th of the Zen Buddhism when finished his study abroad at Seongdeok 21 of Shilla. He enshrined the relics and built this temple. The autumn of Ssanggyesa is one of the Eight Scenic Views of Hadong.

Through Geumsan Zip Wire located in Hadong-gun, you can feel the feeling of flying in the sky for five minutes while watching the beautiful scenery of Hallyeohaesang from Geumsan, which is the highest mountain(849m above sea level) in the south sea.

It's the background for Park Gyeong-Ri's epic novel, "The Earth," and known for a film site. The view of Pyeongsan-Ri's fields and Seongsang River seen from the porch of Choi Champan's guesthouse is especially beautiful. Alleyway full of Korean style houses and traditional houses reserves the view of old country village.

Sancheong

It's a natural resting place with the mysterious energy of Baekdudaegan Mountain. It consists of oriental medicine tourist attractions, Donggi Bonga, an oriental medicinal forest lodge.

The sunset of 1st top, composed of rocks, have been known for its beauty for five generations in order to capture this view with one's own sight. Out of 8 Scenic Beauties of Jirisan, Cheonwangbong is known to be the most beautiful, which makes the sunset on Cheonwang the first scenic beauty of the night.

Its name is derived from old walls because everyone can appreciate the beauty of the graceful Korean traditional houses over the wall.

Cold clear water of the valley, the sound of jade flows ringing the rocks, the sound of wind from the pine trees, and the nature's harmony of bird's singing can all be experience all year round, and the maple leaves harmonize with the scenic in the autumn.

Hamyang

It's very popular among teachers and parents to take their children for their education of nature as it displays various and different views depending on the season; this is an artificial forest regarded as Natural Monument No. 154.

Having a lot of interesting stories, this is the place where Sambongsan Mountain and Beopwhan Mountain meet and Confucian scholars' stone monuments as well as altar of mountain spirit life.

From the upstream of Gyeongcho River, Eomcheon River has the perfect conditions to enjoy rafting as it travels at fast velocity with much volume of water against the landscape of nature's gift.

The site was where old scholars used to share drinks and conversations of their studies, or fill their hunger with rice ball on their way to Seoul. The 6.2km of Sun in Culture Historic Trail following the order of Nollaejeong, Dongjeongjeong, Jungjeongjeong, overviews the forest, valleys, and pavilions that scholars passed through in single sight.

Geochang

Deep Valleys and nearby woods harmonize to present an exceptional natural scenery. It has become a popular summer attraction with its facilities such as pool, boat yard, and outdoors theater. You can also rent a tent to camp out.

Geumwonsan Natural Forest Lodge is known for its view. It opened in 1993, and has been providing visitors with cozy and comfy rest area, along with various cultural assets as well as altar of mountain spirit life.

It was announced as a hot spring region in 1987, but only the Cheongji of Baekdusan is still in service for public hot springs. The water temperature of Gajo Hot Spring is 26.5°C, and is a strong alkali (PH9.7) simple spring with highest quality of smooth and soft water within the country.

The width of the valley is not very wide, but mountain has such enormous forms, to provide a great volume of water. There are also numerous rocks of dry yourself, as well as your clothing after your time in water. The water streams also push its ways between the rocks to create little waterfalls and rapids.

Hapcheon

One of famous Korean temples, Haeinsa Temple's UNESCO World Cultural Heritage (Tripitaka Koreana) designated as a World Cultural Heritage as well as 70 national treasures and relics.

It was constructed for the movie, Taegukgi, in 2003. As it received much attention as a film site of other dramas and movies, it is making its way as another tourism asset of Hapcheon.

The park highlights the historical and civilizational significance of Tripitaka Koreana of 1000 years. As a place to understand and discover the value of Tripitaka Koreana as a common heritage of mankind, the park provides its history before the typhoon to introduce and concentration of the scripture to its hidden scene to experience Tripitaka Koreana visually and spatially.

Hwangmae Mountain (1,108m) is one of top 3 beautiful mountains along with Sobaksan and Baeksan. Consists of strange rocks and bizarre stones of Mansae Pass with the shapes of all the things and Hwachon Plain Ranch Zone surrounding the top of ridge of North western mountain, it is famous for Korea's biggest azalea habitat.
